## **John 3:17NKJV**

Jesus didn't come to keep you out but to bring you in!

Jesus didn't come to condemn you. Jesus came to save!

If you never really see who you really are, you'll never really be who you're really meant to be!

*'but let a man examine himself' means 'to test, prove, scrutinize (to see whether a thing is genuine or not), as metals, to recognize as genuine after examination, to approve, deem worthy.'*

## **John 8:1-12 NKJV**

While He didn't condemn her Jesus did directly say to her '**go and sin no more.**'

Jesus came to save and not to condemn **but He didn't come to ignore.**

## **Romans 2:4 NLT**

*'Don't you see how wonderfully kind, tolerant, and patient God is with you? Does this mean nothing to you? Can't you see that his kindness is intended to turn you from your sin?'*

## **Romans 2:4 NLT**

*'But because you are stubborn and refuse to turn from your sin, you are storing up terrible punishment for yourself. For a day of anger is coming, when God's righteous judgment will be revealed.'*
