TUESDAY

If you always lived like verse 4? How might you change your habits?

How do we ensure that we do not speak from the world's viewpoint?

WEDNESDAY

READ 1 JOHN 7-8

Define what it really means to love one another.

Based on what you say love is, are you a child of God?

What do your words say that you should be doing that you are currently not ?

Study Tips:

- Pray before you start. Jesus is called the Word so how better to know Him that to study the word? Ask Him to help you understand and know Him better.
- Highlight and note. Don't be afraid to note your victories and struggles in your Bible. Highlight passages that are especially meaningful to you. These may be a great help later when you need them.
- Look up related passages. The time you invest in understanding the Word as a whole will multiply your devotion and faith. Go Deep!

FRIDAY

SATURDAY

READ 1 JOHN 4:13-16

In what ways have you testified to what God has done? What more should you be doing?

Who do you know that needs to hear this message? Will you deliver it?
