MONDAY

READ 1 JOHN 4:17-18

Why are the words fear and love used as opposites here?

Why would true love give us confidence?

In the past month or year describe how love has been made more perfect in you.

TUESDAY

READ 1 JOHN 4:19-21

If it is so important to love one another then why do we struggle to do so?

What might the church look like if we really loved each other instead of having a casual relationship.

What should you do to start putting this into practice?

WEDNESDAY

READ 1 JOHN 5:1-3

Are you better at loving God or keeping His commands? Can there be a difference? Explain.

What commands do you find hardest to keep?

What have you made into a greater priority over Loving God lately?

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Study Tips:

- Pray before you start. Jesus is called the Word so how better to know Him that to study the word? Ask Him to help you understand and know Him better.
- Highlight and note. Don't be afraid to note your victories and struggles in your Bible. Highlight passages that are especially meaningful to you. These may be a great help later when you need them.
- Look up related passages. The time you invest in understanding the Word as a whole will multiply your devotion and faith. Go Deep!

What does verse 4 mean to you personally?

What does overcoming the world look like to you?

Today, do you feel like an over comer or one who is overwhelmed?

FRIDAY

READ 1 JOHN 5:6-9

Explain how the water, blood, and the Spirit each testify for Jesus?

Would you say that you are a testimony for Jesus? How or why not?

Why do you think people embrace "God" yet still reject Jesus?

SATURDAY

READ 1 JOHN 5:10-11

What is our role in regard to these verses?

What has stood in the way of your trust in God? What was your response? Is there something in the way right now?

Who do you know that needs to know this testimony? Are you willing to share it?
