A daily study guide for those wanting to go deeper

Use this guide as a personal study or a family devotion. Pray before you start and ask God you help you understand what He wants you to learn. Be faithful to study and pray daily and you will be surprised just how much you will grow.

MONDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:1-3

What “unwelcome guest” has inhabited your life that needs to leave?

Has God ever turned something the enemy meant as a curse for you into something used for His good? Explain.

What has hearing God’s Word prompted you to do recently?

TUESDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:4-5

Explain how your offering might be your time. What are you offering?

What might the storerooms be in today’s church? Are they full or empty?

What should you be doing to ensure your pare of the storerooms are filled?

WEDNESDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:6-9

What have you given host to that needs to be thrown out and sent away?

How might your “room” be purified after some evil is removed?

Consider your “rooms”, take inventory of what might be lurking.

Study Tips:

- Pray before you start. Jesus is called the Word so how better to know Him that to study the word? Ask Him to help you understand and know Him better.
- Highlight and note. Don't be afraid to note your victories and struggles in your Bible. Highlight passages that are especially meaningful to you. These may be a great help later when you need them.
- Look up related passages. The time you invest in understanding the Word as a whole will multiply your devotion and faith. Go Deep!

THURSDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:10

How would you compare this to today? Is there neglect now?

How might you lift up those in full time ministry? What do they need?

If you don't already, start praying daily for your Pastors.

FRIDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:11

Consider the church as a whole, might this be said about it? Why?

What part do you have in putting the House of God in order?

Are you willing to go alone if necessary, in working toward holiness and unity?

SATURDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 13:12-13

What if God called you to bring everything you own and give it away? What would you most want to hold on to? Why?

What are several reasons that churches struggle financially?

What do you own, truly own? Are you willing to give Him that?
