MONDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 6:15

What's God done in your life that would have been impossible for you?

Why do we place limits on what is possible for God?

What impossible thing do you need? Will you "let" God do it?

TUESDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 6:16

What does the church need to do to be noticed like this?

What does the world see when it looks at today's church?

What must you change for the world to see God's mighty work in you

WEDNESDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 6:16

Why do you think the surrounding nations were afraid?

What might our enemy have to fear if you were fully given to God?

What might you want to hold back as yours and not give God?

Study Tips:

- Pray before you start. Jesus is called the Word so how better to know Him that to study the word? Ask Him to help you understand and know Him better.
- Highlight and note. Don't be afraid to note your victories and struggles in your Bible. Highlight passages that are especially meaningful to you. These may be a great help later when you need them.
- Look up related passages. The time you invest in understanding the Word as a whole will multiply your devotion and faith. Go Deep!

THURSDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 6:17-19

What is your enemy trying to intimidate you with?

What is your response when faced with a spiritual battle?

Look up the amour of God. What do you 'wear' daily?

FRIDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 7:1-3

How have you prepared yourself to be fortified? Where are your gaps?

What in your life is fill of integrity? What lacks strength and truth?

Ask God to reveal those things that need attention?

SATURDAY

READ NEHEMIAH 7:1-3

What are the purposes of gates? What are the dangers of having them?

Would you describe yourself as diligent or lazy in closing your gates?

Pray for order and strength in your house today.
