Acts 9:1-2

Why do you think Saul was so intent on seeing this movement stopped?

Can you compare this account to any other in history?

What was so dangerous about 'The Way' in the eyes of Saul and others?

Tuesday

Acts 9:3-4

Be honest, think hard. Have you ever persecuted the Lord? How?

What is your response when God reveals to you some sin? How does He normally do this?

Use this time to pray and ask God to search your heart and reveal anything you need to deal with.

Acts 9:5-11

Why do you think Jesus didn't need to spend time convincing Saul that He was this Lord?

The men heard the sound. Do you think they heard the words or was it noise to them? Explain.

Why was he struck blind? Was it because of the light, or was Jesus using this for something more?

Acts 9:5-11

Was there any significance to being led, being blind and not eating or drinking for 3 days? If so, what?

Compare this with Jesus asking Peter 3 times if he loved Him.

In what way has the Lord given you the opportunity to experience restoration?

Acts 9:12-16

Are you placing yourself in ready positions to hear the Lord when He brings instructions to you? What should you be doing, if not?

Give as many reasons as you can that this might have sounded like a bad idea to Ananias?

What has God done in your life that at first sounded crazy?

Acts 9:17-19

Knowing who Saul was, would you find it hard calling him 'brother'?

What do you imagine some of the conversations were about while he was with the disciples?

What do you think these 'scales' were and was there any significance to them? What scales are over your eyes right now that need to come off?
