Are you filled with amazement with what God has done for you or do you ever think about it?

Why are we really surprised when God chooses to do something miraculous in someone's life?

When is the last time you disowned or rejected Jesus?

Why do you think God continues to call us back to Him when we are so ready to run off?

Friday

Acts 3:17-21

Even though they had reject and killed Jesus, Peter refers to them as friends. Why?

What is the lesson to the church in this passage for how we should communicate with those who reject Jesus today?

Is Jesus our messiah or the messiah of the godless?

Saturday

Acts 3:22-26

Why was it important for Peter to share the words of Moses?

How could the church improve in sharing the word in ways that people understand?

Is there some sin that you need to turn your back on? What will you do about it?
