Unschooling and ordinary. Having not graduated from seminary do you feel unqualified to teach, preach or share the truth with others? Why?

What do you imagine these leaders might have done had the crippled man not been anywhere around?

Knowing their experience with Jesus, do you think they expected Peter and John to really keep quiet? Why?

Friday

How do you answer David's questions?

Saturday

Acts 4:27-31

What is the purpose of gathering on Sunday morning? What is your purpose the other 6 days of the week?

What might be the result if this was our earnest prayer? Are you prepared to say this prayer for yourself? Why or why not?

When was the last time you experienced something like in verse 31? Do you want it to happen?
