Why do you think God demanded that everything was to be destroyed? What is the message to us?

What was the reason for keeping the Silver, Gold, Bronze and Iron yet not the livestock?

What is God asking you to destroy that might be keeping you from depending fully on Him?

Saturday

Joshua 6:22-27

Notice that Rahab, a prostitute, was not only spared, but invited to live with God's chosen. Who in your life needs to hear this message?

What has God saved you from that you thought was unforgivable?
